



Egans Campground Pet Policy

We encourage our campers to share their camping experience with their pets; however we want to ensure that you do not do so at the expense of your neighbours and fellow campers.

Limit of 2 dogs per site. Visitor's dogs are not welcome

1. Aggressive dogs of any breed are not welcome. If your dog shows behaviour that is protective and unfriendly to strangers or other dogs, please leave them at home. If you do decide to bring the dog it must wear a muzzle, for the protection of fellow campers and their pets. Failure to comply with this policy will force us to ask you to find other camping accommodations.
2. All dogs are required to be under the control and visual observation of their owners at all times. A 6' (six foot) leash rule is in effect whenever the animal is outside the owner's trailer, vehicle, motor home or tent. No dog should be left tied up and unattended outside. As well, do not leave your pet locked up inside your camping equipment if you are going to be away.
3. Allowing your dog to bark uncontrollably day or night will not be permitted. If you are unable to control your pet's barking behaviour, you will be asked to leave your pet at home or make alternate arrangements.
4. Your pets must be walked by a responsible person who must clean up after them. There are multiple dog stations throughout the camp
5. Service dogs of any breed are welcome at Egans Campground; however these animals may not exhibit aggressive behaviour.
6. If your pet is tied up outside, you must ensure that your pet cannot go past your site boundaries.
7. You must clean up after your pet on your own campsite as well as when you are walking your pet.

8. All pets must be registered on your Lease agreement, so when your pet is no longer with us, or you get a new pup or kitten, you must inform us in writing immediately. All other pets are not permitted to visit.

We do believe that the majority of pet owners act responsibly most of the time. However, sometimes owners need gentle reminders. If you see anyone violating the rules, please help us to enforce them. If you cannot resolve pet issues and need our assistance, feel free to call the office to report the unresolved issues. Thank you in advance for understanding the need for these guidelines.
